

**Sound: oa written as o-e**

**Learning Objectives:** to review a set of letter/sound correspondences; to learn a main way of spelling the sound /oa/, to read the spelling choice o-e in words and sentences and write it in dictated words and sentences

**Success Criteria:** to read one alternative spelling choice for phoneme /oa/ in words and sentences and to write that choice in dictated words and sentences with 100% accuracy
